ORDINANCE
TO
CHANGE HOOVER AVENUE – SOUTH SPEED LIMITS

The Town Board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective AUGUST 1, 2016, speed limits on the following Town of Plover town highways are reduced and modified as follows:

**25 MILES PER HOUR: HOOVER AVENUE – SOUTH: FROM
STATE HIGHWAY 54 TO POINT JUST
SOUTH OF 5220 HOOVER AVE-SOUTH**

AND

**35 MILES PER HOUR: HOOVER AVENUE – SOUTH: FROM
POINT SOUTH OF 5220 HOOVER
AVE– SOUTH TO INTERSECTION WITH
BIRCH DRIVE**

- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*

- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on posting or AUGUST 1, 2016 (a specific date after posting, allowing adequate time for erection of signs).

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
