TOWN OF PLOVER DOG OWNERS DOG LICENSES DUE BY MARCH 31ST

The Portage County Ordinance requires that by March 31st of each year or upon reaching 5 months of age all dogs must be licensed and have a current valid rabies vaccination. **Licenses issued AFTER MARCH 31ST will cost an ADDITIONAL \$5.00 LATE FEE.**

<u>License fees IF:</u>	<u>PRIOR TO APRIL 1ST</u>	<u>THEREAFTER</u>
Spayed or Neutered	\$ 8.00	\$13.00
Unsprayed or Unneutered	\$18.00	\$23.00

To obtain a license for your dog, the current copy of your dog's rabies vaccination certificate provided by the veterinarian must be provided.

Dog licenses for the Town of Plover may be obtained at the Town Office at 5081 Hoover Avenue – South, Plover. Hours are Monday thru Friday from 7 to 10:30AM and from 1 to 4PM. If you have questions, call 344-7684.
