TO TOTALLY OPT OUT OF IOH LENGTH AND WEIGHT LIMITS


**WHEREAS**, 2013 Wisconsin Act 377 under Section 348-27 (19)(b)5.a. provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Section 340.01(4) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Section 340.01 (1o) of Wisconsin Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wisconsin Statutes,

Now, therefore, **BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Town Board of the Town of Plover, of Portage County, that pursuant to Section 348.27 (19)(b)5.a. of Wisconsin Statutes, implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wisconsin Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wisconsin Statutes.

Further, **BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** that this resolution shall be in effect for the calendar year of 2015, and that this resolution shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the town board.

Further, **BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** that a copy of this ordinance shall be provided to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to be posted on the state DOT WEBSITE.




