

ORDINANCE No. 20200819

The town board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That pursuant to Wis Stat. ss. 60.30(1e)(a), the combined office of the clerk/treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per ss. 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under ss. 17.001 and required by ss. 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the town board to be held on November 3, 2020. The referendum question shall be:

"Shall the person holding the combined office of clerk/treasurer in the Town of Plover, Portage County, Wisconsin, be appointed by the town board?"

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.






